

ONLINE SAFETY ACT

The Online Safety Act is Australia's legal framework that promotes a safer digital ecosystem and seeks to prevent online harms.

The Act is currently under review, and the review will consider the need for further protections to address online harms and what steps can be taken to ensure the tech industry acts in the best interests of children on their services.

The reviewer must report back to the Australian Government by 31 October 2024, and then the Government will respond to the review's recommendations including through amended legislation.
